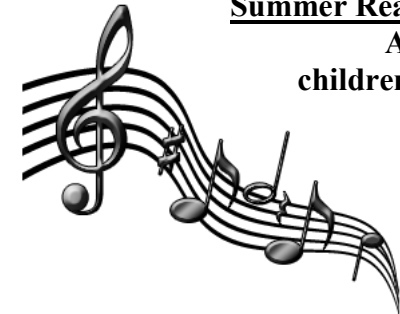

### **What is OverDrive?**

It's a software service that the library subscribes to which allows library users to download e-books and audiobooks from home.

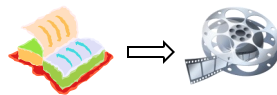
**Who can use it?** Anyone with an El Reno Library account.

**Where can I use it?** OverDrive is a product you can use on your home or work computer. You'll need internet access and the ability to download and install software. Unfortunately, you can not use the public computers at the library to download OverDrive titles at this time.

**Do I have to read/listen on my computer?** No, you can transfer your titles to various MP3 players and e-readers. OverDrive's website lists compatible players and readers.

**Will the library help me?** Sure! Just remember that we're learning too. We hope to offer some free classes about using OverDrive in Fall 2011. Stay tuned!
