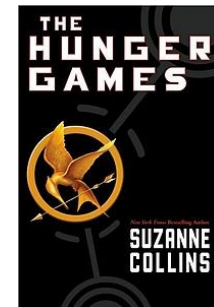
Borrow free books for your E-Reader
